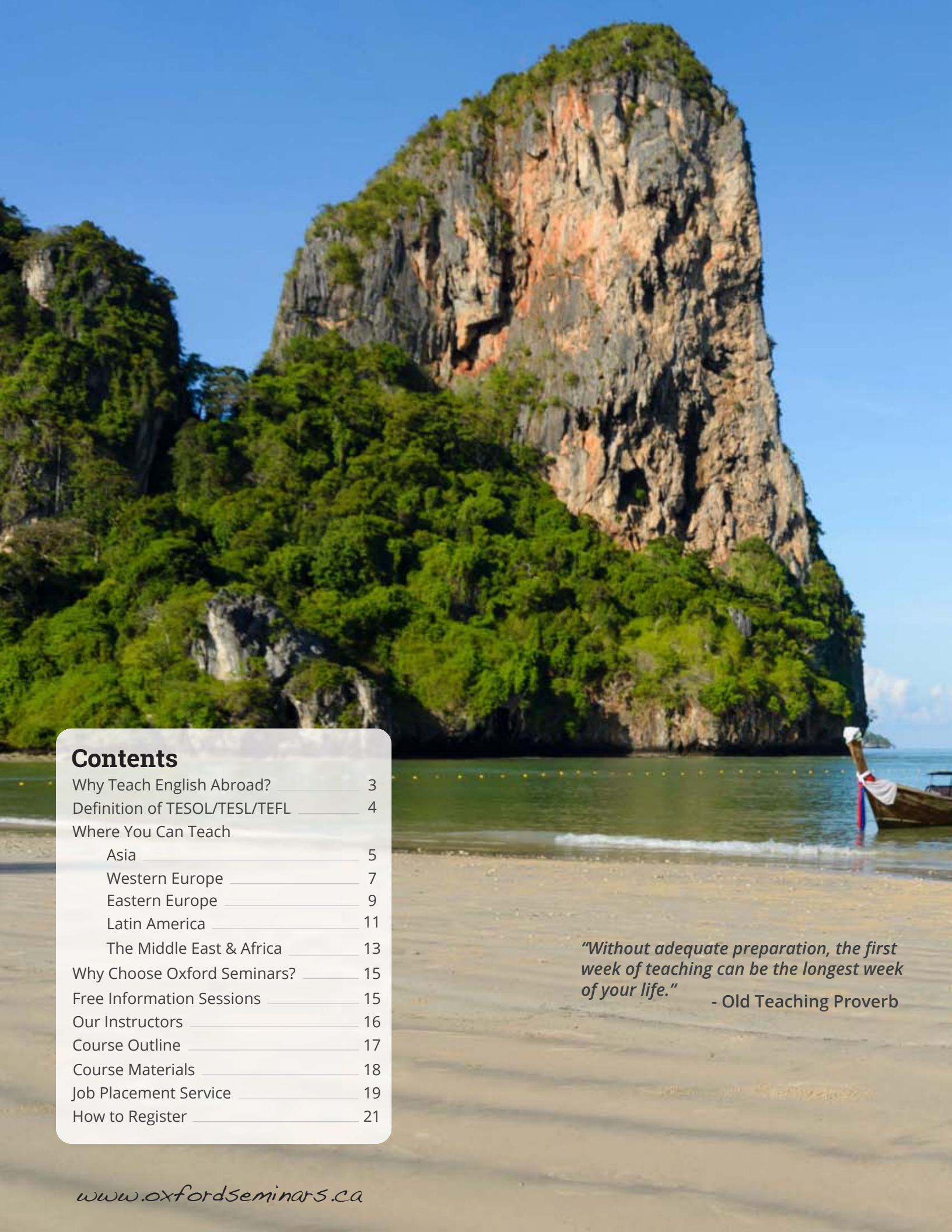

What is the difference between TESOL, TESL, and TEFL?

They are interchangeable terms that essentially mean the same thing.

TESOL = Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages

TESL = Teaching English as a Second Language

TEFL = Teaching English as a Foreign Language

Certain acronyms will be more common depending on where you will be teaching.
